I am reaching out to forward the street closure information for [ONE Musicfest](#), taking place on Saturday and Sunday, October 8th & 9th in Central Park/Renaissance Park/Civic Center Parking Lot. Festival hours are from 12PM to 11PM on Saturday and 12PM to 10PM on Sunday.

For closed streets that require resident access, we will be distributing parking passes in the week before the festival. I will send an email about when and where those will be available closure to the date.

We are also taking seriously our goal to keep the neighborhood clean. ONE Musicfest has contracted waste and recycling management services to provide pre-event area clean-up, event waste disposal and post-event area clean-up. Clean-up crews will restore all event areas to their original condition and will extend out 2 blocks from the event perimeter.

ONE Musicfest will be enacting the same safety protocols we have always had for the last 14 years. Each attendee is subject to a bag and wand search. Our list of allowed/prohibited items can be found on our [website](#). We reserve the right to deny entry to anyone for any reason. We will be offering refunds for anyone that is denied entry to the festival. We have APD and private security on site to ensure our attendee and area safety. We have *never* had any instances of violence at our festival in our 14 year history. Our attendees know what to expect and bring their good energy and family reunion vibes with them to the festival.
